



# Broad General Education (BGE) Senior Phase

# Looking to draw on your experiences to aid future progress

BGE

- What we offer as choices
  - Electives skills based
- If we change our offer in the Senior Phase then learning would look different in S3
- Choices for S2 (9) and S4 (6 or 7)
- Registration / Pupil Support Time

**SENIOR PHASE** 

S4 changing from 6 subjects to 7

#### S4 changing from 6 subjects to 7

- More choice of subjects (broadening the curriculum) for S4 and then for progression into S5/6
- Our data is extremely positive for pupils who get 6 National 5s and then 5 Highers or equivalent level 5 and 6 NPAs – the top 20%
- This is targeting attainment in the middle 60%
- 9 choices at the end of S2 the 7 choices at the end of S3 would need to be from the 9

#### **Personal Support Possibilities**

#### 32 Periods per week

- Monday & Tuesday increase by 10 minutes
- Wednesday, loses a whole period but 10 minutes is added, therefore finishes 40 minutes earlier
- Thursday & Friday are 10 minutes longer
