You will work towards a HNC in Applied Sciences and a SVQ 3 in LATA (Education Science) @ SCQF level 7.

The entry requirements for this course are: -

Minimum 1 Higher qualification in a Science subject e.g., Mathematics, Chemistry, Physics, Biology or Human Biology and 2 Nat 5 qualifications 1 of which should be English and the other an additional Science subject or Mathematics or equivalent.

A Foundation apprenticeship in Science or a NC in Applied Science.
