Dear the staff and students of Harris Academy,

On behalf of Dundee Foodbank, I would like to express our sincere gratitude for your incredibly generous donation which totalled 450kg. This will help us supply approximately 50 people with a nutritionally based three-day emergency food parcel.

Dundee Foodbank is committed to providing emergency food relief to individuals, <u>couples</u> and families experiencing hardship throughout the city of Dundee and its surrounding area. In 2020, we were able to assist over 14,200 people with a non-perishable food provision and we are currently feeding over 200 persons per week.

We are anticipating a very busy winter period with the cut to Universal Credit and the rising costs of fuel, food, and energy. Your donations are vital to ensure we can keep up with what will likely be significant demand over the next few months.

We are incredibly grateful to the continued support we have received from Harris Academy over the years. Thank you for all you have done for us.
