



Keyworker spaces at Harris Academy Monday 22nd February – Friday 5th March.

Please complete the attached form if you are a keyworker and have exhausted all other childcare options, you (and your partner) are keyworkers and are not working from home. Young people should only attend the Harris Hub on days that you are (both) working.

1. Attendance is only available to parents/carers who have exhausted all other childcare options. Please tick the boxes below to confirm that you have read and understood this guidance.
 - If your job or the job of any other adults in your household do not fall into one of the three categories below, then you should keep your young person at home.
 - In addition to being a keyworker in one of the three national categories, you must also have exhausted all other options before sending your young person to school.
 - If you or another adult in the household is not working or can work from home, then your young person should not attend school. The only exception to this is where there is an adult in the household who is at home but cannot provide supervision due to significant medical issues.
 - If there is a relative or friend who can reasonably provide childcare through an informal childcare arrangement, you should not send your child to school. Informal childcare arrangements are permitted at this time. You can find more information on this link: [Parent Club](#)

 - Category 1: Health and Care workers directly supporting COVID-19 response, and associated staff; Health and Care workers supporting life threatening emergency work, as well as critical primary and community care provision; Energy suppliers (small numbers identified as top priority already); staff providing childcare/learning for other category 1 staff.
 - Category 2: All other Health and Care workers, and wider public sector workers providing emergency/critical welfare services (for example: fire, police, prisons, social workers), as well as those supporting our Critical National Infrastructure, without whom serious damage to the welfare of the people of Scotland could be caused.
 - Category 3: All workers (private, public or third sector) without whom there could be a significant impact on Scotland (but where the response to COVID-19, or the ability to perform essential tasks to keep the country running, would not be severely compromised).
