- Sunglasses
- A water bottle (which can be refilled)
- Any required medication
- Money (recommended both GBP and EUR)

Additional Information

- On our departure, we advise you to ensure the young person has GBP with them in order to buy food for lunch at the airport/on the plane. They could bring food with them, but please ensure it is suitable to be taken through security (ie. No liquids exceeding 100ml.)
- We ask that you travel in the t-shirts we have made for the trip.
- On our return, we advise you to ensure the young person has EUR with them in order to buy food for lunch at the airport/on the plane. They could buy this before our airport transfer, but please ensure it is suitable to be taken through security (ie. No liquids exceeding 100ml.)
- Each young person has **1** piece of hold luggage which must not exceed **23kg** and **1** small carry-on bag. Please put all liquids into hold luggage.
