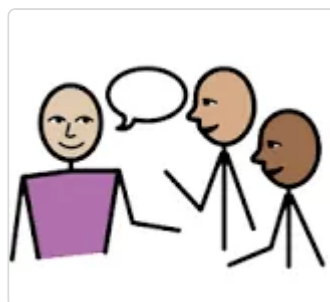
During our last meeting we discussed period products becoming more accessible.
