If you have a concern about a grade (or grades) which are marked on your certificate, you can appeal directly to the SQA or you can ask this school to do this on your behalf. This service will open on results day, Tuesday 8th August at 9am submission deadlines are,

- Tuesday 15 August at 11:59pm for priority appeals
- Tuesday 29 August at 11:59pm for all other appeals

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Parent Portal

- links to the basic information provided by you and held securely on the Seemis database by your child's school. You can view information or update details at a time that suits you.
- uses the secure My Gov login also used for other Dundee City Council services. If you don't yet have a My Gov account, you'll create one at registration for the Parents Portal.

We hope that the Parents Portal and its services will become an integral part of home school communications for you and so will enhance your child's overall school experience, and we would encourage and value your support in registering for this service.

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Modern Languages Department – Recent Achievements

<u>P7 Passport to Europe transition event</u> saw over 250 young people take part in a variety of language focused activities.
