Dear Parent / Carer,

With the Spring holidays upon us, I wish all our families an enjoyable break.

Our senior pupils are gearing up to the first set of SQA exams held in three years and my advice to them would be to balance their time between studying, with quality time with family and friends. Returning to school fresh, energised, happy and prepared will serve them well in the lead up to the exams.

Our Easter school (information below) runs through both of the holiday weeks, and, with the help of additional Scottish Government funding, we hope to offer Masterclass sessions on the evening before each exam, along with a Saturday morning revision school which will run from the first Saturday back until the end of the exam diet. More information on our Masterclasses and Saturday school will be communicated to you during the first week back.

For our S1 – S3 pupils, we have 6 weeks left of our current timetable before the young people move up a year group. This week, we have appointed S3 prefects who will take on the role of supporting staff in ensuring a calm, positive and respectful environment during the course of the SQA exam diet. Congratulations to all 27 of our young people who were successful in their appointment. A small number of young people are still to be interviewed. This will take place after the break.

As noted in last week's newsletter, we return to school with the majority of our safety measures in place and I would appreciate your ongoing support in both supplying face coverings and encouraging the appropriate use of them (where and when appropriate). If you have any questions in relation to the changes to the Asymptomatic Testing Programme, please feel free to contact the school via the main office. The most important point to note is that any young person or staff member showing any symptoms of COVID should isolate and arrange a PCR test as soon as possible.

Finally, allow me the opportunity to thank all members of our school community for continuing to support one and other.

Easter School – All S4 to S6 Pupils

Any classes that have been pre-selected by S4 to S6 pupils for the Easter school will run as planned. A list of those classes, with the pupil names, is available outside the library should anyone wish to confirm the dates and times they have selected.
