# FP Association Bingo Night

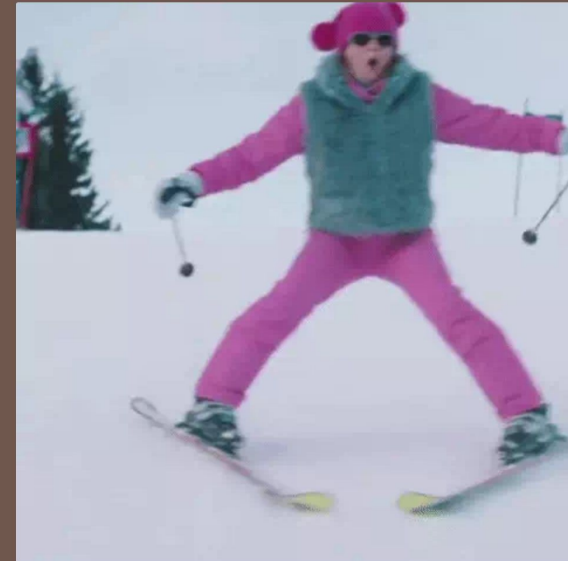
The school's FP Association Bingo Night which was due to take place on Thursday 7th March, has been cancelled due to lack of interest.

# Pavement Parking Restrictions

## For information, this week, Dundee City Council's parking enforcement team will start to issue Penalty Charge Notices (£100 fine) for three new parking contraventions.

1. Pavement Parking - no part of vehicle to be on the pavement
2. Dropped Kerb Parking - crossing points should not be blocked by parked cars
3. Double parking - parking on the outside of another vehicle (or e.g Eurobin).
