
Supporting Our Learners

Attendance

A reminder that learning starts at Harris Academy at 8.45am every day. A warning bell sounds at 8.40am to alert young people to the fact that they should move towards their period 1

class to receive their welcome from their respective class teacher and be ready to maximise learning time. As you will know improving Presence in our school via improved levels of attendance and lower latecoming rates are whole school priorities this session. Studies have shown that there is clear correlation between positive levels of attendance and high attainment levels for young people.



Some interesting facts from attendance studies which may be of help as we begin a new academic year:

- $\,\cdot\,\,$ A student with 95% attendance from August to June will have missed approximately 60 learning episodes
- A student with 90% attendance equates to half a day off per week, 19 days off per year and 247 days off over a school career which is equivalent to over one academic year of lost learning
- · A student with 85% attendance across an academic year (August to June) will have missed approximately 250 learning episodes
