IMMUNISATION (Keep on until the 13thFeb)

12th and 13th February S3 Boys and Girls.

Diphtheria, Tetanus and Polio are highly infectious diseases that can all result in death. Men ACWY vaccination protects against 4 different strains of meningitis.

The school health team will be in school on the 12th and 13th of February to administer the vaccines therefore any forms still at home please bring them in with consent signed by parent or carer. New consent forms can be completed on the day of immunisations for those who have lost forms.

On the day- Short sleeve shirts, t-shirts under shirts or sleeves that can roll right up. Please have breakfast.

Immunisations will be in school in rooms 3304 and 3305, timetable will be displaced in school nearer the date.

This vaccine was last given when you were 4 and to maintain immunity it is important you get this final booster at this age which should prevent you getting any of these diseases.
