

### Improve attainment




### **RESPECT EQUALITY ENJOYMENT ACHIEVEMENT**

#### Improve attainment (3.2)

- Monitor the progress of all young people in S<sub>4</sub> during the first year of our amended (7 National qualifications) curriculum.
- Ensure all young people have at least 5 qualifications by the end of S4
- Identify specific areas for improvement based on the release of INSIGHT in September
- Increase the number of young people who achieve Level 3 or better by the end of S3, particularly young people who are from SIMDQ1, Care Experienced and ASN

### Implement our tracking and monitoring system in the Broad General Education (2.3, 3.2)

• Ensure we have a robust tracking system that will impact on outcomes for learners in the BGE at classroom, department, and whole school level



### Develop our refreshed whole school approach to Numeracy and Literacy in the Broad General Education (2.3, 3.2)

- Implement a 'Literacy Standard' across all departments
- Ensure all departments have, and use, a subject-specific word bank
- Audit Literacy and Numeracy Es and Os coverage across all departments
- Reintroduce our Numeracy strategy

### Develop study methods at all stages (3.2)

- Agree standard, consistently used study techniques for use across all departments
- Offer a 'Study Hall' for young people to access at lunchtime and after school which is pupil-led
- Offer a course planner for all subjects at all levels





### Implement a revised home learning strategy (2.3, 3.2)

• By October, have a revised policy, with all stakeholders' views taken into consideration, in place that is in full operation

### Embed our Standard for High Quality Learning, Teaching & Assessment (2.3)

- Ensure all staff are fully aware of the key components within our Standard to enhance the consistency of approach observed throughout the school
- Offer appropriate CLPL to support the consistent use of the Standard
- Promote the Standard via improved visuals on display across the school and in every classroom
- Create and use a Microsoft Team for all individual classes in all year groups

### Embed pupil voice at all levels (1.3)

- Ensure pupil voice is at the heart of classroom, departmental and whole school improvement processes
- Strengthen our current pupil voice model to incorporate a Pupil Parliament include groups such as Pupil Voice, UNCRC, LGBTQ+, Wider Achievement and Learning & Teaching groups

## Improve the experience of all learners (1.3, 2.2, 2.3)

- Increase the number of social events for all year groups
- Review the S2 elective programme and decide whether there should be a place for School of Sport (and/or Expressive Arts) Complete a final review of our current RfL policy and increase the priority level of recognising positive behaviours in learning




### Reduce latecoming (3.1, 2.3, 3.2)

- Agree shared messaging to staff, young people and families as to the negative impact of latecoming
- Implement a 'payback' system to account for lost learning

### Implement our Harris Standard for Health & Wellbeing (3.2)

- Agree a process to track the wellbeing of all young people in all year groups and ensure appropriate interventions as a result of the collected data
- Reintroduce Mental Health First Aiders



### Improve attendance (3.1, 2.3, 3.2)

- Review attendance policy
- Improve engagement to increase attendance
- Appoint a dedicated attendance team to focus on improved attendance (generic and targeted groups)
- Use P7 data effectively to work with young people with attendance concerns during their transitionary phase
- Arrange dedicated time for the Guidance team to focus on attendance and raise the expected impact on attendance tracking
- Agree a data set and tracking process
- Implement a registration period and ensure attendance monitoring is central to its purpose (for session

25-26)
