Although the date has not yet been set, Dundee City Council schools will start virtual learning towards next session's qualifications earlier than usual.


As soon as further details emerge, I will let you know.

The deadline for estimates to be sent to SQA has been extended by a month, giving all schools more time to finalise the estimates which will be sent to SQA.
