Then can we ask that each registration class fills one shoe box with the items required below.

Your class can choose who the box is for.

## 6 steps to bring happiness

### 1. FIND

Find an average-sized shoebox. Decide who to fill it for; a child, a teenager, a man or a woman.

### 2. WRAP

Wrap your box and lid separately so that the lid can be removed without tearing the paper.

### 3. PACK

Gather the items, remove any excess packaging and pack into the box.

### 4. CHECK

On the checklist, tick the items you have put in your shoebox and note any that are not on the list.

### 5. DONATE

Secure the ticked checklist to the outside of the shoebox lid using sticky tape. Detach the donation envelope as instructed and place with your donation inside your box.

### 6. DELIVER

Secure the lid with rubber bands. (Custom regulations require Blythswood Care to check the contents of your box.) Deliver your box to your local collection point.



**For Christmas delivery your shoebox should be at your church, school or other collection point week commencing 28 October 2019**
