Senior Reports

Current COVID cases

Like many schools throughout Dundee, we have seen a significant rise in the number of positive COVID cases, resulting in a significant number of young people and staff self-isolating.

Public Health have been in contact with me and are happy with our COVID mitigations which we have in place. Their advice to us all who work and study in the building is to:

- Wear a face covering properly (covering nose and mouth) in all areas of the school building
- Sanitise hands as often as possible
- Remain 2m apart wherever possible

To do all we can to limit the spread and to stop the need for people to self-isolate, I have asked all colleagues to be extra vigilant around the school in relation to the points above.

Arrangements for August

Current guidance from Scottish Government suggests that the same mitigations will be in place for our return to school in August. I plan to write to all families over the course of the last week of the holidays with a full update.

Arrangements for new S1 pupils on Tuesday 17th August

To support our new S1 pupils on their arrival with us for their first day as members of our Harris Academy family we have arranged the following:

- 1. All young people starting S1 should arrive for a **9.15am start**. Our S2-6 pupils will arrive for the normal 8.45am start. This will provide us with the opportunity to target our full support to our new S1 pupils, via a staggered start.
- 2. On arrival our new S1 pupils should report to the entrance doors noted below (this information was

covered during the transition visits):

Tayview PS pupils Clock Tower entrance

Blackness PS pupils Art entrance
Ancrum Rd PS pupils Front entrance
Camperdown PS pupils Maths entrance

Invergowrie PS Clock Tower entrance

Victoria Park PS Maths entrance
All non-cluster pupils Front entrance

Prefects and staff, including members of the SLT, will be on hand to support at all entrances.

A more detailed letter will be sent to our new S1 families, via respective primary schools, at the start of next week.

House Championship and Prizegiving

The decision has been taken, due to the nature of the school year, to share the House Championship across all four Houses.

House points gained between August 2020 and January 2021 will be carried forward into next session's competition, ensuring that the hard work of the Houses before we entered lockdown, will not be in vein.

Our digital prizegiving will be available online during next term with all prize-winners being announced on our return in August. All leaving S6 winners will also be notified in advance of the ceremony.
